DUE ON OR BEFORE WEDNESDAY, MAY 15, 2024

- Students who will complete all requirements for high school graduation prior to the official graduation date in May of the graduation cohort will be eligible for Early Graduation.
- The student must complete and submit the Early Graduation Application Form to the school counselor by <u>May 15, 2024.</u>
- Upon review of the completed application and supporting documents, the principal will notify the student of the date for his/her interview.
- A letter must be written to the superintendent, <u>Mr. Jeffrey Beckwith</u>, explaining your reason for requesting early graduation and your plans after graduation. (Letter should be written legibly in black or blue ink, or typed.)
- Please note the following:
 - O You will no longer be considered a student at Woodland High School, but you will be allowed to attend Prom, Graduation and senior picnic if dues are paid.
 - o It now becomes your responsibility to keep up with all the information and events happening here at the school.
 - o <u>BECAUSE YOU WILL BE A JANUARY GRADUATE, YOU WILL NOT BE</u> <u>RANKED WITH THE CLASS OF 2025.</u>
- If you are applying for early graduate as a junior, please note the following:

Students who desire to graduate early must have Superintendent and Board approval. In addition, if approval is granted, the student will forfeit their opportunity to be considered for ranking within the top ten percent of the class. Student must successfully pass ALL classes and makeup any seat time needed prior to the end of the semester. In addition, the student must have met all of the requirements for a State High School Diploma, State Certificate, and/or South Carolina Employability Credential.
