

## ACT WORKKEYS TEST ADMINISTRATION (12<sup>TH</sup> GRADE)



The ACT WorkKeys assessment is primarily administered to 12th grade students in the Pine Bluff School District. In the state of Arkansas, all students in grades 10–12 have the opportunity to take WorkKeys before they graduate. The assessment measures essential work skills needed for success in jobs across industries and occupations and represents work readiness through the National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC). The purpose of the NCRC is to provide students with a workplace certification that demonstrates their preparedness for the workforce, and measures their knowledge and skills in Applied Math, Graphic Literacy, and Workplace Documents. There are four certified NCRC levels: Platinum, Gold, Silver, and Bronze.
