



ACT WORKKEYS TEST ADMINISTRATION **(12TH GRADE)**



The **ACT WorkKeys** assessment is primarily administered to 12th grade students in the Pine Bluff School District. In the state of Arkansas, all students in grades 10-12 have the opportunity to take WorkKeys before they graduate. The assessment measures essential work skills needed for success in jobs across industries and occupations and represents work readiness through the **National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC)**. The purpose of the NCRC is to provide students with a workplace certification that demonstrates their preparedness for the workforce, and measures their knowledge and skills in *Applied Math, Graphic Literacy, and Workplace Documents*. There are four certified NCRC levels: **Platinum, Gold, Silver, and Bronze**.
