- Review and sign progress reports and report cards
- Attend parent-teacher conferences and participate, when appropriate, in decisions relating to the education of your child
- Request conferences as needed with your child's teacher
- Volunteer in your child's school (possible exceptions could apply during pandemic)

Student's Responsibility:

- Come to school prepared
- Complete and return homework
- Ask for help when needed
- Provide parents with all notices and information received from school
- Be responsible and respectful
