

Did you know?

All children who are at least **5 years old on September 1** of the year of entrance can be enrolled in kindergarten.

Children come to kindergarten with a wide variety of skills and abilities.

There is no such thing as “ready” or “not ready” for kindergarten.

Enrolling your child in kindergarten provides them with many important opportunities:

- Free education designed for young learners with caring teachers and staff.
- Time with same-age peers to support learning and build friendships.
- Access to free early childhood screenings, special education and related services, mental health supports, and language services when needed.
- Meal services, transportation, and out-of-school programs. Check with your school about available options!

Eligibility for kindergarten is based on age, not ability, knowledge or skill. Kindergarten is a place to grow and develop, including learning skills that support school success.
