

Suggested Protocol for On-Site COVID-19 Testing - RPCS

Purpose

1. To keep patients that will be tested separate from screened building occupants
2. and to minimize patient's access to other parts of the building.

Before Testing (Preparation)

Tester & Testing location: The Tester is the Health Aide or other designated person that will administer. Tester will wear two masks (double masks), wash hands, put on gloves, and wear a face shield. The testing location will be the isolation room or other designated room in a convenient location to minimize risks.

Test Kits: Test kits will be laid out following testing procedures.

Patients: It is assumed that patients have waited at least 3-4 days after exposure. Patients must call ahead and set an appointment with the Tester. Patient should not touch anything while on location. Patients will be allowed into the building one at a time from a different location from the main entrance screening. All patients must wear a mask.

During Testing

1. Patient arrives on campus with parent. They will park in the area across IT building in 412 Parking Lot.
2. Patient calls Tester
3. Tester opens and holds door open for patient. Patient sanitizes hands.
4. Patient is escorted to testing location.
5. Tester conducts COVID-19 test.
6. Tester escorts patient back out of the building and holds door open for patient to exit.
7. Patient returns to and remains in their parent's vehicle to wait for results.
8. Tester will text results to patient's mobile phone when it is time to read the test result.
9. Test is complete. Test result is recorded and the result is texted to patient and parent. Patient and paren is given further instructions.

After Testing

Test location is sanitized by tester.
