

### **About the District and Community**



Fremont is a community of historical significance. Located on the Sandusky River, it is home of the 19th president of the United States, Rutherford B. Hayes, honored with a museum, grounds and home that are open to the public.

As a forward-thinking community, Fremont takes pride in rich academic, athletic and performing arts programs. In January 2022, the district completed the final phase of a district-wide PreK-12 facilities replacement program with the opening of the new Ross High School. In addi-

tion, other educational opportunities such as Terra State Community College and Vanguard-Sentinel Career & Technology Center are located in Fremont. Institutions of higher education are within a short drive and include Bowling Green, Tiffin, and Heidelberg Universities.

Fremont is home to several large manufacturers including Crown Battery, ABC INOAC, Style Crest and Kraft Heinz. The healthcare industry is strongly represented by ProMedica Memorial Hospital, Community Health Services (CHS), NOMS Healthcare, the Dorothy L. Kern Cancer Center, and dialysis centers. Another important organization and employer is the Great Lakes Community Action Partnership (GLCAP).

The district is conveniently located within an hour's drive to both Sandusky and Toledo and is within 30 minutes to Lake Erie and Cedar Point. Fremont is the ideal city to live, work, play and educate.
