- **Post-Secondary Plans**

 2. Click on *About Me* drop down menu at the top right
 3. Click on the *Graduation Survey* option at the bottom of this drop down menu
 4. Be sure to click submit when you are done
- *Is student aware of how to request an official transcript for college applications?*

 2. Click on the ACADEMICS drop down menu at the top
 3. Click on the TRANSCRIPT REQUEST option and complete the form accordingly

- **Community Service Hour Updates**

- Per recent district updates; Graduating class of 2023 are now only required to complete Community Service Hour Requirement for the Class of 2023
- Please note that OSSE's soon-to-be released Emergency and Proposed Regulations will gradually reintroduce community service hours over the next 4 years. The following expectations will go into effect for the class of 2023:
 1. All students who graduate in 2023 must complete a minimum of 12 community service hours.
 2. Students who transfer into DCPS during SY22-23 and graduate in 2023 will have the community service hour requirement waived.
 3. These Emergency and Proposed Regulations will apply to all students who graduate in 2023, including midyear and early graduates. Once OSSE's final regulations are released, we will provide additional information.
