

0164 - NOTICE OF REGULAR MEETINGS, HEARINGS, AND WORKSHOPS

Pursuant to State law, the School Board shall, at least seven (7) days prior to any regular give notice of public meetings, hearings, and workshops provide notice in the following ways:

- A. (x) continuous publication on a publicly accessible website as provided in F.S. 50.0311 or the office Board website;
- B. () by publication in a newspaper of general circulation; or
{DRAFTING NOTE: If there is no newspaper of general circulation in the District, select this option instead:}
~~() an announcement over at least one (1) radio station whose signal is received in the District a reasonable number of times daily during the forty eight (48) hours immediately preceding the date of such meeting;~~
- C. ~~() by posting a notice at the courthouse door if no newspaper is published in the county. on the District's website not less than seven (7) days before the public meeting, hearing, or workshop;~~
- D. ~~by mail to all persons who have made requests for advance notice of the Board's proceedings, and to organizations representing persons affected by any proposed policy; and~~
- E. ~~by posting in appropriate places so that particular classes of persons to whom an intended action is directed may be notified.~~

The notice posted shall include a general statement of the general subject matter to be considered.

~~Notice of special meetings shall be made in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation in the county sufficiently in advance of the meeting to allow the public to attend. Such notice shall contain the date, time, place, and purpose of the meeting.~~
