

Empathy is the ability to understand and connect to the feelings of another.

Empathy is the central component of emotional intelligence. There is a huge need for empathy in our world because, as anxiety increases in our culture, empathy decreases. So, we are working to develop a few key skills in order to live more empathetic lives.

 First, developing an "emotional vocabulary" to make sure we have the words to understand and describe what we are feeling personally.



 Second, being able to connect with others based on their feelings even though we may not

have the exact same story or perspective as someone else.
