Governing Board Meeting Summary February 9, 2022

Student Board Member Report

Student Board Member, Lainie Radomsky, presented the Student Board Report for TVES and EGJH. <u>Student Board Report - February 2022</u>

Superintendent Report

Dr. Scott Hagerman's reports included the <u>Superintendent Report, February 9, 2022</u> and the <u>AEL Projected Budget Cuts</u>, where the following information was outlined in detail:

- Covid Update Pima County remains in high transmission, however the numbers are currently decreasing.
- Construction Update Construction is proceeding well, and progress on buildings can be seen throughout the district.
- Aggregate Expenditure Limit (AEL)

Information was provided on the history of the AEL, including the historic context of the current issue. Please see the presentation for more detailed information.

Main Points:

- District schools across Arizona would have to cut \$1.2 billion beginning in April 2022 if a resolution is not passed before March 1, 2022.
- The Tanque Verde Unified School District will lose \$2.6 million in current year funding if the Arizona Legislature does not pass a resolution allowing school

- districts to exceed the aggregate expenditure limit.
- These are funds that have already been allocated to districts, it is not new money. It does not allow school districts to overspend their budget

Dr. Hagerman explained we do not anticipate having to close our schools, as some other districts may have to do. However, we may have curriculum materials and other resources we would not be able to purchase as planned. We have just had our capital budget restored, and to have the funding pulled away again will have serious ramifications.

The two big impacts for TVUSD will be the curriculum items, and our careful financial preparations for the anticipated recession will be negated and will have long term effects. The Board Members discussed communicating their concern to our legislative representatives. Information will be made available on the website.

Safe Return to In-Person Learning Plan

The Safe Return to In-Person Learning Plan 3rd Revision was approved by the board. The revision was approved to reflect the updated Pima County Mask Ordinance dated December 21, 2021, which is to remain in effect through February 28, 2022. The district will then follow County or State requirements.

Student Learning Update

Dr. Amy Cislak, TVHS Principal, Greg Miller, EGJH Principal, Chris Rietz, ACES Principal, and Emma Batty, TVES Principal, presented information about their recent Professional Development work with Janel Keating.
