SCHOOL-PARENT COMPACT

 - Identified grade level and parent – teacher conferences will be scheduled throughout the school year
 - Parent – Teacher Conferences will be held annually on Statewide Parenting Day
- **Provide parents with frequent reports on their children and school's progress.** Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:
 - Provide progress reports every four (4) weeks
 - Provide INOW training
 - Provide quarterly bulletins
- **Provide parents reasonable access to staff.** Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:
 - A time that is convenient for all stakeholders
 - Grade level meetings once each semester
 - Annual Title I meetings will be conducted once during the morning hours and once during the evening hours
 - Statewide Parenting Day
 - Home School Community meeting/Report Card Pick-Up
 - Open House
 - Quarterly home visits
 - Family Literacy Night
- **Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as follows:**
 - Opportunities for parents to volunteer included but are not limited to: participating on the ACIP Committee, the Parent Advisory Board, the Campus Beautification Committee and other committees
 - Orientation for Volunteers
 - Staff will have copies of the Helping Hands Volunteer application in their classrooms- and volunteerism will be discussed during faculty meetings
- **Ensure regular two-way, meaningful communication between family members and school staff and, to the extent practicable, in a language that family members can understand.**
 - Frequent communication by way of face-to-face, electronic, paper and phone in a language the family can understand.

Parent Responsibilities


We, as parents, will support our children's learning in the following ways:
