Administration

3. Aid in implementing and coordinating parent involvement programs throughout the district.
4. Provide information to parents in a format and, to the extent practicable, in a language the parents can understand.
5. Describe curricula used in general education setting and intervention/enrichment.
6. Provide a welcoming environment for parents and students.
7. Be accessible to parents.

School Representatives/Title I Teacher

1. Provide high quality curriculum and instruction in an effective learning environment.
2. Meet the needs of your child through ongoing, two-way communication with parents.
3. Regularly communicate with you and the classroom teacher on your child’s progress.
