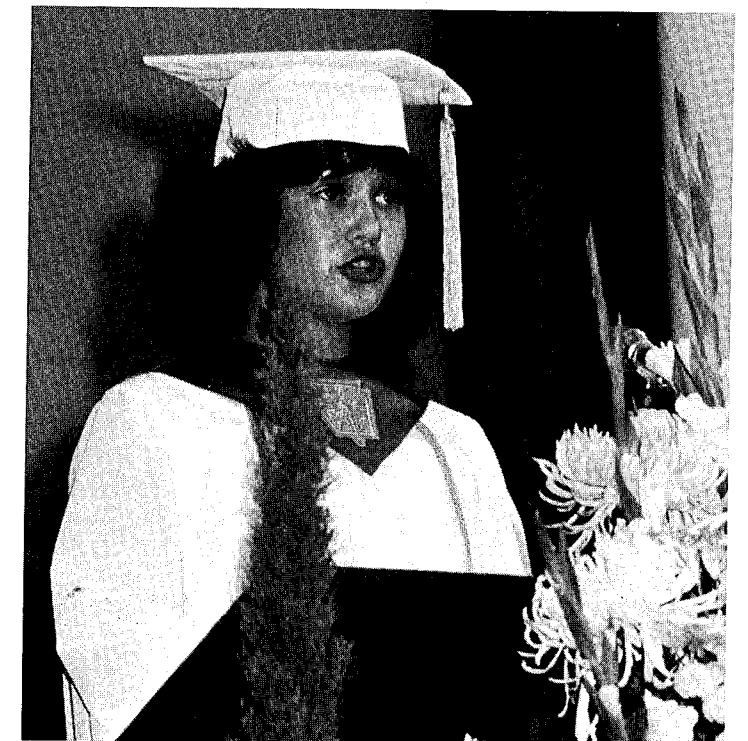
Congratulations Class of '83
