Good Afternoon PLES families!

Attendance: September is Attendance Awareness Month. We are placing additional emphasis on student attendance in the month of September and are providing incentives for attendance.

PowerSchool Parent Portal: Reach out to your child's teacher for information about Parent Portal if you have questions or didn't receive the sheet that was sent home several weeks ago.

Car-Rider Parents: Please have your sign hanging from the rear-view mirror. Please take the sign down when your child is in the car. Parents, stay off your cell phones during car-rider line.

Spelling: Parents, please begin practicing weekly spelling words Sunday evenings.

Attendance: Students who check-in before 11:30 or check-out **AFTER** 11:30 are considered PRESENT. Students who check-out **BEFORE** 11:30 or check-in after 11:30 are considered ABSENT. This is how we determine if a student is PRESENT or ABSENT each day.

Absences: If you child is absent, you have 3 days to turn in excuses. They can be parent notes, doctor's excuse, court excuse, etc. After 3 days, the absence will be considered unexcused.
