- We will have **Make-ups for the History State Dual Credit Exam** this morning in the library. Today is the only day to make up State Dual Credit exams.

- Students will be allowed to purchase a **stamped envelope** from the Snack Shack beginning Monday, May 16 for \$1. Students can also bring stamped, self-addressed envelopes from home, if they wish. **Self-addressed stamped envelopes should be turned in to the Front Desk.**

- Students need to request **Drivers Permit Certificates** through the main office. This process generally takes 24 hours before it is complete. You can stop by the front desk to request a Certificate.
