## TRANSPORTATION POLICY

North Country Charter Academy is not obligated to provide transportation. However, to the degree that NCCA determines that transportation shall be provided, such transportation shall be considered a privilege, and subject to the following:

Students Driving Themselves With Their Own Vehicle

Both North Country Charter Academy sites have public parking lots that are shared by other businesses. We expect that all students will behave responsibly when driving themselves. Any student caught driving in a reckless manner will be referred to the Principal/Center Director to determine whether or not the student will be allowed to transport themselves.

Students are allowed to bring motor vehicles to the Charter Academy and to the school in which he/she is scheduled for vocational classes. All vehicles must be registered with the North Country Charter Academy main office.

North Country Charter Academy Transportation

North Country Charter Academy contracts its transportation services. Four main routes of pupil transportation have been established and include the following areas: Route #1: Colebrook, Stratford, Groveton and Lancaster; Route #2: Berlin and Gorham; Route #3 Linwood and North Woodstock; Route#4: Woodsville, Bath, Lisbon and Littleton.

## Student Transportation Code of Conduct

The transportation contractors and drivers will have responsibility to maintain orderly behavior of students in the transportation vehicle and will report misconduct to the Principal of the Charter School in writing. All students will be expected to abide by the rules and regulations set forth by the transportation contractor. The Principal will have the authority to suspend the riding privileges of students who are disciplinary problems and fail to conform to the rules. Parents of students whose pattern of behavior and conduct in the transportation vehicle endangers the health, safety, and welfare of other riders will be notified that their children will lose school transportation privileges in accordance with the student discipline code
