Keep Calm and Check Your Sources

JMS students have been learning how to determine the reliability of internet sources. Here are a few questions to ask about sources before using them for research:

- 1. Do you know who is in charge of the website?
- 2. Does the website have a reliable domain?
- 3. Are the factual claims supported by cited sources?
- 4. Is there any bias that you notice?
- 5. Does the website have outdated information?
- 6. Are there any grammatical or spelling errors?

These students used a credibility checklist to evaluate two websites and then chose the most credible source.









Learning about Digital Footprints

Your digital footprint is the trail of information that you leave behind each time you go online. This includes all social media activity. Fifth graders recently learned that digital footprints can impact future jobs and college scholarships. These students also evaluated three fake social media profiles and easily identified the person with the most positive digital footprint.



























Student Book Recommendation
