





Count of Tennis court improvements (resurface and maintain playing area) Cost \$100,000 (602 Responses)




Count of Bleacher replacement in Owosso High School Gym


Count of Parking lot and some sidewalk replacement at most buildings (except Central's parking lot which was resurfaced in 2023)




Count of Masonry and structural upgrades at all buildings including Willman Field




Count of Bathroom renovations at most buildings (except Emerson which was completed in 2023)



Count of Interior plumbing including replacing cast iron pipes at all buildings





Count of Drainage improvements at all buildings including Willman Field




Count of Roof replacement and upgrades at all buildings (except Bryant, which was completed in 2023) Cost \$4,200,000 (601 Responses)




Count of Partial window replacement at all elementary buildings Cost \$2,208,000 (601 Responses)




Count of Build 3 additional classrooms and another restroom at Bentley Bright Beginnings Cost \$2,500,000 (603 Responses)




Count of Track improvements including fixing cracks on the track and repainting and sealing the track surface Cost \$100,000 (595 Responses)




Count of Varsity Baseball and Varsity Softball Field Lighting Cost \$1,500,000 (598 Responses)




Count of Construct secured vestibules at Washington, Bryant and Central Cost \$950,000 (597 Responses)






Count of Fire suppression upgrades at all buildings (except the Secondary Campus) Cost \$3,500,000 (602 Responses)




Count of Classroom lighting replacement at all buildings (except Emerson and the Secondary Campus, which were recently completed) Cost \$2,500,000 (595 Responses)




Count of Asbestos abatement at the Secondary Campus Cost \$507,000 (603 Responses)




Count of Fencing improvements at Bryant Cost \$265,000 (602 Responses)




Count of Competition Soccer Field at OHS (Turn practice field into competition field with spectator seating.) Cost \$750,000 (599 Responses)







All of these items are critical but I feel upgrading buildings heating and cooling are most crucial to our students and staff. The buildings are unbearable in the heat and freezing in the cold. Students can't properly learn and staff should not be expected to work under these conditions.

Any maintenance that will preserve the current instructional buildings for longer should be the highest priority.

Anything pertaining to the structural safety of the buildings should be a priority before bleachers, track resurfacing, etc

Anything safety related I feel is a FULL NEED.

Apply for all the grants possible- this could be a business class project to research and find available grants- this can try to offset some of these costs, I would love to see all these improvements. Can we think outside of the box and install solar panels along the back drive of school or on the roof to help offset some of the consumers bills which I'm sure are pricey, most all of teachers run AC units in their classrooms so that moves down the priority of that. Heartland HS has a whole athletic complex where they have solar panels and two wind mills there on the property. Move our football field to the high school campus and have everything at that campus- Willman has horrible parking and is a money pit, leave our pool in the high school and knock out the back wall for raised seating, our pool is in decent condition if you're going to spend the money on The pool build a whole new aquatic center that can host meets to generate revenue for us, knocking out the back wall people could still park underneath this or add additional bathrooms and locker rooms under, bathrooms at the track or baseball fields with drinking fountains are needed so kids (&parents) can fill their water bottles, let us bring our cups back in Willman field! If we invest in our sports we attract more students and if our kids are in sports it keeps them busier and out of trouble!!

We should have a room dedicated to infants and a room dedicated to toddlers to help with the care demand. Bentley also needs better play ground surfaces for the toddler playground. Education facilities that directly affect classroom learning is ALWAYS more important than sporting facilities. In modern times, air conditioning is now a need.

Equip all classroom doors with special stoppers and defense mechanisms to help protect any intruders in case of emergency scenario.

Facility maintenance to preserve the community's investments educational investments should take precedence over other projects.

Field Turf would be a huge waste of money. Restroom facilities are much needed by the track. It amazes me that there are not any facilities there besides a porta-potty. Security Bell- Camera needs to be on the outside of the building at high school main entrance. You have to enter the building to ring the bell. It's too late at that point.

Fix the bones of the schools first. The rest should follow. I would hope that actual structure repairs & equipment to keep the schools running in good, safe conditions would be 1st priorities over any sporting arena requests - just common sense to me.

How do you plan on doing this without a mill increase?

I am excited for my son to go thru the OPS school system, and implementing these improvements would make his experience that much better, on par with other schools in the area.

I don't know all the details of the bids but I 100% know that the lighting for the ball fields should be considerably less the 1.5 million. Champion Electric did Durands Football stadium with polls for 165k

I feel Construct secured vestibules at all elementary schools should have been done a long time ago. Safety and security of children and staff shouldn't be open for debate/discussion.

I feel like we should build a new football stadium at the Owosso high school.

I feel that the most important thing that needs to be fixed is having air conditioning in every classroom in the middle/high school. Seems to be the new systems went to cooling the gym and the weight room. I feel that the classrooms are a higher priority in need of the air conditioning.

I feel there should be a push to improve the pool environment. Our program could be much stronger if we had space to grow.
