STUDENT REQUIRED INFORMATION

Dear Parents:

I would like to share with you some facts and figures from the request for information that was in the Parent Communication dated September 7, 2023.

Only 83 families filled out and sent in the requested information, which consists of 113 students out of 268 students. This information helps the school secure state and federal funding for materials. These numbers are quite alarming to us due to the lack of participation. This means that 155 of our students did not participate.

Also included in that request for information was an Emergency Form that lists other contacts. In case of any Emergency, this information leaves in binders with some of our teachers so that we can contact families or other members listed to impart VITAL information. If the computer system goes down, this serves as our back up.

If you were one of the families that DID NOT fill out this information, please take the time to do so and send it in to the Main Office as soon as possible. Please refer to the Parent Communication Packet dated September 7, 2023, to have access to the required forms.
