Writing In Sills

Formal Writing: Personal Narrative

Students focus on personal narratives in this unit. Students will plan, draft, edit, and publish personal narratives. Students first practice writing a personal narrative as a group using an event experienced by the whole class, then write their own personal narratives about a real event in their lives.

Informal Writing:

Notes, graphic organizers, responses to text, building and expanding sentences with adjectives and prepositions.

Formal Writing: Informative/Explanatory

In a multi-day, step-by-step process, students learn the elements of instructional writing. Students plan, draft, edit and publish a writing piece on a topic of their choice that gives clear, multi-step instructions in a logical order.
