# What is it, and How Does it Work?

Twilight School is a **free** opportunity for students to master standards that were unsuccessfully attempted (failed) during the first semester of the school year. Students who received a failing grade in a course for the first semester will take a pretest to determine which standards need to be recovered in order to earn a passing grade. Students will only be required to master standards identified by the pretest.

### How will Students Earn a Passing Grade?

Students will work through an online platform (Edgenuity) during Twilight School. Certified teachers in each subject will be available to assist students during those times. Students are also allowed to work on their standards at home. Students will be able to earn a 60% for the first semester grade if the course is completed successfully.

# Do Students have to Attend Twilight School to Earn the Passing Grade?

**YES.** Students must attend each Twilight session until they have completed their assigned tasks. **Students will be dismissed from Twilight School after missing two days regardless of their current grade/progress in the program.** 

#### Who is Eligible?

 Current PHS students who earned below a 60% in a core class during first semester and have seven (7) or less unexcused absences for first semester

\*\*eligibility, course availability and space will determine if a student is selected for the program

# **How do Students Register?**

Completed Twilight School Applications should be placed in a drop box in the front office of PHS from **January 10-January 18, 2024** to be considered.

### **Prattville High School Twilight School Program**

#### Instruction

- 1. All courses will be under the supervision of a Board-approved facilitator.
- 2. Standards recovered will be aligned with the state standards set forth and approved by the Alabama State Board of Education.
- 3. ImagineLearning Edgenuity will be the virtual learning program accessed by students while enrolled in Twilight School.

# **Student Eligibility**

- 1. Applicants should have no more than seven (7) unexcused absences for the first semester.
- 2. Students who have earned a grade of less than 60% on a 100 point scale are eligible.
- **3.** Students who need core course standards available within the platform. Not all course standards are offered.
- 4. Students must complete an Autauga County School System Twilight School application.

# **Course Availability and Space**

- 1. Course availability and space will be determined by the PHS Twilight School staff based on registration numbers and the ability to fully service and supervise students.
- 2. Students may only recover standards in core courses available within the online platform.
- 3. The ptogram is offered at no cost to students.

#### Attendance and Removal

- 1. Students are required to attend Twilight until all requirements have been met.
- 2. Students will be removed after missing two days of Twilight School.
- 3. All students will comply with the rules set forth in the *Autauga County School System's Code of Conduct*. Any infractions will result in removal.

# Schedule

- 1. Twilight School registration will be available from January 10- January 18, 2024.
- 2. Twilight School will be offered Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:15-4:45PM beginning January 23, 2024.

#### **Transportation**

Parents/Students are responsible for transportation for the Twilight School program. Any student who is more than 15 minutes late for pickup will be removed from the program.

#### Grades

- 1. A mastery score of 60% or higher must be obtained to receive credit for the lost standards through Twilight School. A proficiency score of 60% or higher will allow the student to move to the next section in the sequence.
- 2. Students may recover multiple courses if time permits. However, one course must be completed before attempting the next.
