Dear Parent/ Guardian:

This summer, Tawas Area High School will be continuing a summer school credit recovery program for eligible students who failed core academic subjects during their high school career. The Plato Credit Recovery System is a comprehensive, standard based online curriculum used by thousands of learners in more than 2,000 schools and education programs. The Plato on-line courseware gives each student an individualized path to success.

In determining eligibility, we used State of Michigan guidelines. **For this summer only, we are able to award students the opportunity to complete 2-3 semester classes for credit recover.** The Summer School and Credit Recovery programs were adopted to give students an opportunity to redeem themselves academically. Students will have a certified teacher monitoring their progress and assisting them on an individualized basis, if necessary.

**Classes will be held Mondays through Thursdays from 8:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. Starting Monday July 10<sup>th</sup> and continuing for 6 weeks (ending August 18<sup>th</sup>).** Students will enter the high school building through the High School Cafeteria Entrance, summer school will be hosted in the High School Cafeteria. Lunch and transportation are not provided. Students can participate from 8:00 am -10:00 am, 10:00 am – 12:00 pm or stay for the full time 8:00 am – 12:00 pm.

Tawas Area Schools will pay for the cost of attending summer school. However, failure to complete or pass the course, will result in 100% of the cost becoming the responsibility of the student/family. These charges will be issued in Skyward and could impact your student's ability to register for future summer school opportunities as well as graduation.

**Should the student not fulfill the minimum requirements of the student contract, the student will be dis-enrolled and miss out on this opportunity.** We look forward to working with your son/daughter and getting him/her back on track academically.

In order to official register for summer school, students and parents need to sign and return the Summer School Commitment contract.
