 In 1540, Spanish explorer Hernando de Soto and his forces first set foot in what is now Alabama.
- 5) Who was the first explorer to explore the Mississippi River? <u>Hernando de Soto</u>
- 6) What did King Louis XIV send his men in the Mobile area? <u>King Louis XIV sent women for the men to marry.</u>
- 7) Which country has heavily influenced the Mobile area? What are some names that we still use today?

<u>France was the country that has heavily influenced the Mobile area and gave names to Mardi</u> <u>Gras, azaleas, Bienville Square in Mobile.</u>

- 10) Who owned land west of the Mississippi after the American Revolution? <u>After the war that established the United States of America, the land west of the Mississippi</u> <u>River was controlled by The United States.</u>

- 11) Who gained New Orleans in the War of 1812?The United States gained New Orleans in the War of 1812.
- 12) When did Alabama first become part of the United States? <u>Alabama became part of the United States for the first time when American troops accepted the</u> <u>surrender of the Spanish at Fort Charlotte on April 13, 1813.</u>
- 13) Who wrote the Declaration of Independence?
 <u>Two members of the committee to write the Declaration of Independence were Benjamin</u> <u>Franklin and Thomas Jefferson.</u>
- 14) What is the US Constitution? Where was it written?

The United States Constitution is a basic set of laws. Delegates met in Philedelphia, PA and agreed to write the Constitution.

- 15) What is the Bill of Rights? <u>The first ten amendments to the Constitution which spell out the rights of United States' citizens.</u>
- 16) What did the Europeans want when they came to America?

The Eurpoeans wanted to own land and become wealthy.

- 17) Who was Hernando de Soto?
 <u>Hernando de Soto was a conquistador, explored much of the Deep South looking for gold.</u>

The first permanent colony by Europeans was led by Don Tristan de Luna, a Spaniard living in Mexico.

In 1699, explorers from France built a fort and settled in the area of Mobile at Twenty-seven Mile Bluff.

<u>Alexander McGillivray was the first child of Lachlan McGillivray and Sehoy Marchand, was</u> <u>educated in South Carolina, became the chief of the Creek Nation and fought for America in the</u> <u>Revolutionary War.</u>
