




The claims for the reporting period is based on the dates of service of the medical Claims and the Fill Date of the Pharmacy Claims. The "Claims per K" value represents an adjusted value based on a set number of 1,000 Members, which allows for comparisons from year to year or across different groups. The Top 1% represents the members within the group that incur the most healthcare expenses. For example, in a group of 1,200 members, this would represent the 12 members in the group that spent the most healthcare dollars. Typically, these are individuals with chronic diseases or those who have experienced severe trauma. Capital Health Plan's Disease Management and Complex Case Management programs assist the employer group in controlling these costs by identifying these individuals and inviting them into programs that help coordinate care for their specific condition.

What was the membership composition for this reporting period?

Health insurance is typically offered in a tiered structure, for example, Employee only, Employee and Spouse, Employee and Dependents, and/or Family coverage. This allows for varying the amount of premium for each employee depending on the needs of coverage. Membership composition affects the pricing and overall costs of healthcare for an employee group. As the average number of family members in a group rises, the premium does as well, to offset the risk of covering larger families.











The purpose of preventive visits is to screen for diseases, such as high blood pressure or diabetes, look for future disease risks, such as high cholesterol and obesity, encourage a healthy lifestyle, such as healthy eating and exercise, update vaccinations, and maintain a relationship with your primary care physician in case of illness.



As you know, PPACA, encourages people to get the preventive services they need by requiring that most health plans cover certain services recommended by the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force, an independent group of medical experts that evaluates scientific research and makes recommendations about clinical preventive services. Other preventive services are also covered without cost sharing, including recommended vaccines and services related to women's and children's health screenings.

The chart and graph above counts one preventive visit per calendar year. The "CHP" category represents all of Capital Health Plan, including the group for which the report is being issued. The current year displayed will usually represent a partial calendar year, and as a result, may show a lower percentage than previous years.




Tier 1 medications typically include the lowest cost drugs and are usually comprised mostly of generic drugs. The shift of utilization from brand-name drugs to generics continues. The charts on the previous page and this page reflect the group's Tier level fills and costs and then compares the group's data to that of Capital Health Plan overall. Specialty drugs, included in the highest tier level, are typically used by a small percentage of people to treat such conditions as hepatitis C, multiple sclerosis, cystic fibrosis, rheumatoid arthritis, and cancer, but due to their high costs, they generally represent the largest portion of a group's overall pharmacy costs. Capital Health Plan focuses on physician education, transparency, and utilization guidelines to ensure the appropriate use of medications and to manage these costs effectively.
