Advisory Board/School Council Minutes February 27, 2026

The LRPS Advisory Board/School Council met on February 27, 2026. Members present at the meeting were Mr. Jack McKee, Ms. Melissa Lee, Ms. Melanie Gladden, Ms. Rachel Gibbons, and Dr. Rush.

Dr. Rush reported the following:

We are still collecting data on our School Climate Survey. The survey window closes at the end of March and we are looking for additional families to take the survey.

Our book vending machine has arrived and is located in the Media Center. Title 1 funds will be used to stock the vending machine full of books throughout the school year. Currently, students who earn Colt Cash for demonstrating STAR expectations can use their Colt Cash on books from the vending machine. Next year, the plan is to allow students to get a book from the vending machine on their birthday.

The Central Office provided LRPS with the allotment for next year. Currently we have some vacancies for the 2026-2027 school year. Ms. Jolly, Kindergarten teacher is retiring at the end of this school year so her position will need to be filled. LRPS gained an Early Intervention Program (EIP) slot that will need to be filled. We are also adding an MID special education self-contained classroom to our school, so we need a teacher in this position. We also have one paraprofessional retiring.

Dr. Rush shared winter MAP results from the MAP Student Growth Summary Report. Students in grades 1-2 made significant gains from Fall to Winter on both growth and achievement.
