Addressing disciplinary problems in manifestation determination meetings and expulsion proceedings.

Obtaining compensatory education funds for past deprivations of FAPE

Pursuing reimbursement for private school placements
Stopping bullying and disability-based harassment within the school

Litigating disability discrimination and retaliation claims
