



NYM e-Learning Plan

e-Learning days may be implemented during the 2022-2023 school year if we experience inclement weather days beyond our snow make up days. The state of Minnesota allows for districts to use up to five e-Learning Days per school year. The New York Mills School Board approved the use of e-Learning days, in the event that we have more inclement weather days than we have make up days scheduled in the district calendar. Please read through this document and review the key highlights to be aware of when an e-Learning day goes into effect.

General information about e-Learning Days:

 In New York Mills, e-Learning Days will be implemented only after all snow make up days are used in the 2022 - 2023 school calendar. These e-Learning Days can negate the need for makeup school days at end of the school year, helping families accordingly.




 An e-Learning Day is a day where a school offers full access to online instruction provided by students' individual teachers due to inclement weather. 120A.414

 e-Learning Days allow students to work from home, avoiding potentially dangerous commutes.

 e-Learning Days are intended to counter the loss of curriculum momentum resulting from school cancellations due to Minnesota's winter weather.

 Students are expected to participate in e-Learning activities for all scheduled classes on the day the plan is used. Students who do not participate in planned activities are considered absent for the classes unless prior arrangements have been established.

Communication - SchoolMessenger, Facebook, District Website: Just as in the past, school cancellations and e-Learning Days will be communicated through the district notification system. This will also be posted on the school district website, and the District Facebook page. **Teachers, principals, and other licensed professionals will be available from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and again from 12:00 p.m. to 3 p.m.**



K-4 Learning: Staff will communicate learning expectations using SeeSaw in kindergarten through 4th grade. Assignments will be turned in paper form the next in- person instructional day or electronically, at the teacher's direction.



5-12 Learning: All students are required to log in for attendance no later than 9:00 am. For their first period class. Additionally, students will log into Google Classroom for each of their classes to find and complete assigned tasks for the day. Assignments will be posted in Google Classroom no later than 9:00 am for the day. See instructions for those without Internet access.

Appropriate Learning Opportunities for All: Google Classroom allows teachers to provide differentiated learning opportunities for our students based on IEP/504 requirements, accommodations, or best practices. For further assistance please contact your respective case manager, counselor, or school social worker.



E-Learning Days

The NYM School District may choose to utilize e-learning days in the case of inclement weather AFTER the scheduled snow make-up days are utilized.

Homes without Internet/Wifi Connection: Every effort will be made to send home materials in advance with students who do not have wifi capabilities at home. Students using Google Classroom may be asked to download materials before leaving school, if it appears that inclement weather is possible the next school day. When this is not possible, students without Internet access will receive their assignments upon returning to school.



Activities: In the event that school is dismissed early, canceled, or an e-learning day due to severe weather, all extra-curricular activities including games, practices, and open gyms will be canceled.
