GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. A minimum of 25 credits is required for graduation for the class of 2025
- 2. Four years of English
- 3. Three years of science including 1 year of Biology
- 4. Three years of mathematics including one year of Algebra and one year of Geometry content.
- 5. Two years of social studies including U.S. History and U.S. Government -must pass US and IL Constitution tests
- 6. Four years of physical education including one semester of Health and a course in Driver's Education
- 7. One year of a fine art, foreign language, music, or vocational education
- 8. 1 semester of Consumer Education- (Consumer Economics & Personal Finance)
- 9. Electives (minimum of 7 credits)

- *Electives are available in speech, foreign language, mathematics, science, social studies, career and technical education, music, and art.
- *Dual credit courses in English, Health Careers, Science, Math, Social Sciences, and Computer Networking are available through Black Hawk College.
