### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. A minimum of 25 credits is required for graduation for the class of 2025
2. Four years of English
3. Three years of science including 1 year of Biology
4. Three years of mathematics including one year of Algebra and one year of Geometry content.
5. Two years of social studies including U.S. History and U.S. Government  
-must pass US and IL Constitution tests
6. Four years of physical education including one semester of Health and a course in Driver's Education
7. One year of a fine art, foreign language, music, or vocational education
8. 1 semester of Consumer Education- (Consumer Economics & Personal Finance)
9. Electives (minimum of 7 credits)
