Report of the Principal Mr. McCook

PBIS Update: Robert Walker and Chad Ekey took over and are working on moving us from emerging to operational and improvements have been ongoing all year. Working with students to improve behaviors without ISS/OSS. We have decreased discipline 30%. We are recognizing students using Demon Dollars as rewards (earning paycheck). It is a way to recognize/celebrate students who are doing the work every day unnoticed. Southside Baptist is one of the community shareholders who have helped with pizza for Demon Dollar Redemption Days. \$3500 Demon Dollars were cashed in this month. These celebrations and recognitions will impact behavior/graduation rate.

Tier 2 Support System: Struggling students who check in and check out will go to a person in the building to help them improve and become more accountable to improve attendance and grades. This gives students a contact person to begin and end the day-to have encouraging conversations.

Operation 90: We are working to move the graduation rate to 90%. We are currently working on tracking those who leave our school, improving attendance, and streamlining the withdrawal process. We were at 83% last year. There are 60 Seniors we are watching/working with to help get them across the stage. We could reach 92% if all Seniors in the building are successful. Our goal is 90%.

School Report Card: We get lots of support from the Central Office. We started with a 2 and it seems we will end with a 2. Teacher/student engagement is a big piece. Our summer focus will be how to improve engagement and strategies to add flexibility to classes while maintaining rigor. Most of the issues come from work session portion of teaching framework.

Safety Update: We have implemented the SmartPass digital system. Students have 2 passes per day but teachers can override for emergencies. The feature included being able to keep “no-contact” students who are having issues apart. Those students will not be allowed out of class at the same time. Data and pattern recognition is very helpful in deterring misbehavior and preventing problems. This tracks how often and how long students are out of class so mitigation can happen to improve academic success. There are only 3 people allowed in each bathroom at any given time to cut down on problems. Students can request a meeting with Admin or Counselors and will accept if available, or can follow up later.

Question: Problem with bathroom doors not locking and doors will be replaced.

Graduation: Friday, May 24 @ 7:30. Families will receive 10 tickets.
