## **EXPECTATIONS FOR PARENT INVOLVEMENT**

Freedom Elementary has adopted the following parent involvement policy and plan. This policy and plan for implementation have been developed jointly and will be distributed to all parents/guardians of Freedom Elementary students.

Freedom Elementary School shall schedule an annual meeting at a time that is convenient for all parents. All parents are invited and encouraged to attend. Freedom Elementary School shall offer a flexible number of meetings (both a.m. and p.m.) to parents. The school may provide transportation, childcare, and home visits.

Freedom Elementary School shall involve parents in an organized, ongoing, and timely manner in the Title 1 planning, review, and improvement of programs; including, the joint development of the school parent involvement policy and school wide plan.

- Timely information and opportunities to attend regular meetings
- School performance profiles and their child's individual assessment results, including interpretation of results
- A description and explanation of the school curriculum, assessment, and proficiency levels
- A timely response for any parent suggestions
