The Horace M. Albright Training Center Employees Association will award at least one scholarship of \$1,000.00 to a Grand Canyon High School 2022 graduating senior.

The scholarship may be used toward tuition or related education expense at any accredited two- or four-year university, college, or trade school in the fall of 2022 or spring of 2023.

The applicant must provide the following in their scholarship application package:

- 1. A personal narrative that addresses the following questions:
 - How has living in or near a National Park influenced your goals for your education and career?
 - What school do you plan to attend?
 - What major do you intend to pursue, and why?
 - How will this scholarship help you reach your goals?
 - Essay should be limited to one-page/double-sided, with 12-point font/one-inch margins.
- 2. Two letters of recommendation:
 - one from a teacher,
 - one from someone who knows you well.
- 3. A copy of your high school transcript showing a minimum of a 2.5 grade point average.

Applications must be postmarked, electronically submitted, or directly delivered to the Albright Training Center front desk no later than 4:30 PM, <u>Thursday, April 28, 2022</u>.

This year's applications will be reviewed anonymously with a focus on the following categories: past performance, future potential, financial and personal need, and individual character. The review panel will be comprised of Albright Training Center employees: Robert Maxon, Tara Harbert, and Betsy Donehoo.
