- For 6th grade nominees = play 2 pieces from the beginning book starting with the number 25 and the B flat major scale.
- 7th and 8th grade = play the all-district music and the B flat major scale and one other major scale of choice.
- 9-12th grade = play the all-district music and 3 major scales of choice

Vocal

- Resume
- 2 letters of recommendation
- 4-5th = sing 2 contrasting pieces, at least one acapella.
- 6-8th grades = sing My Country Tis of Thee acapella. (give the starting note) and 1 other song of choice with or without accompaniment.
