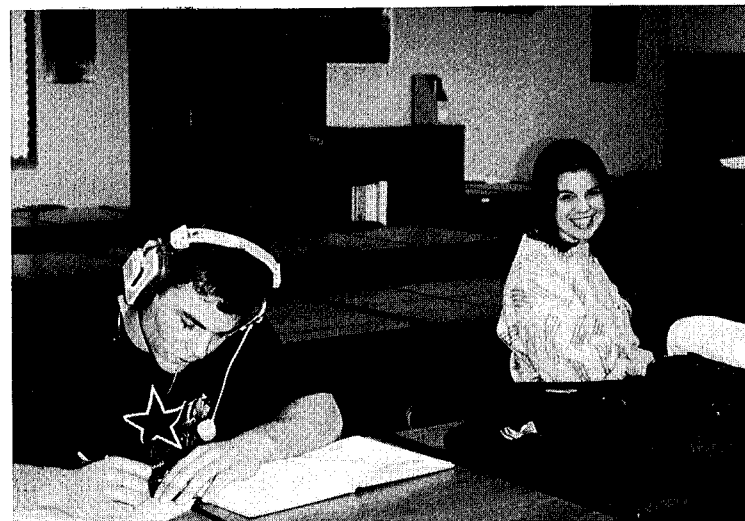
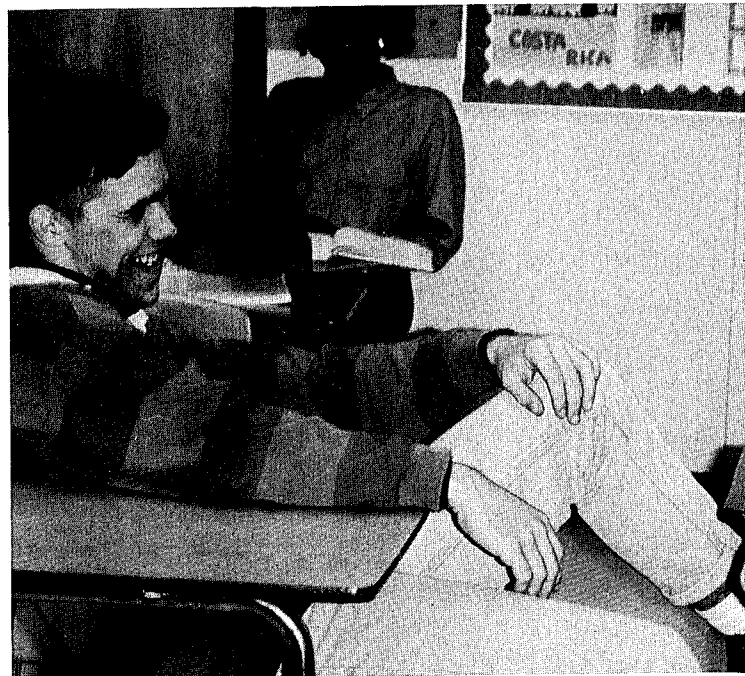


Inner-Space Talk

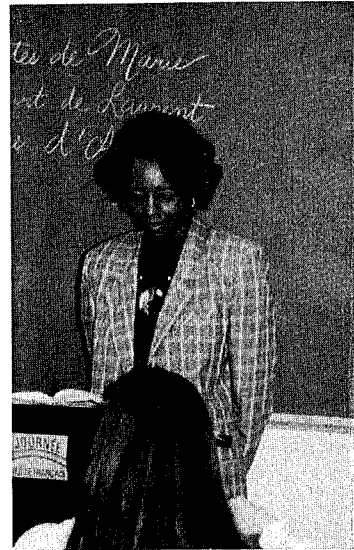

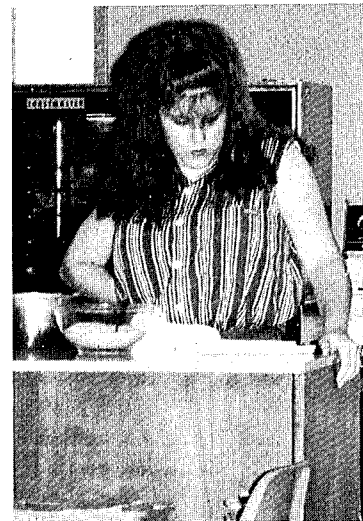
Homey Atmosphere

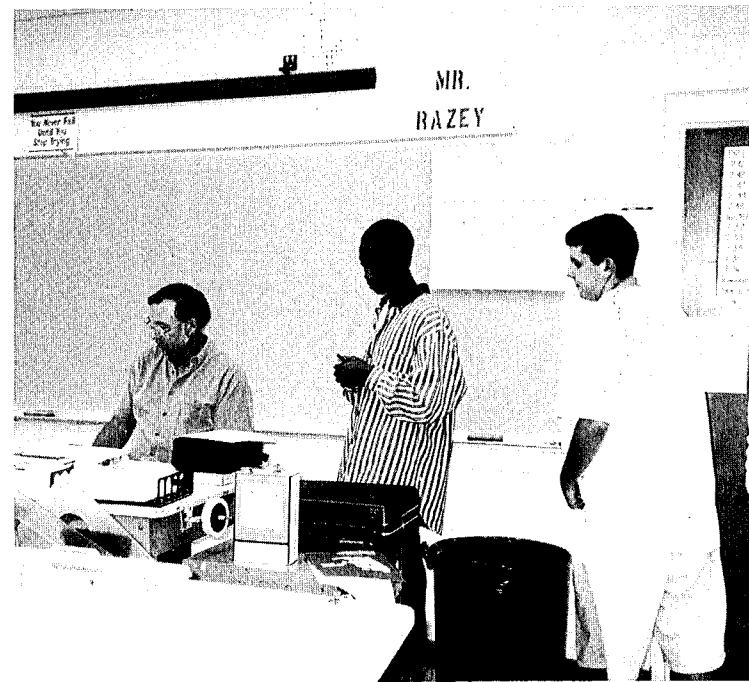
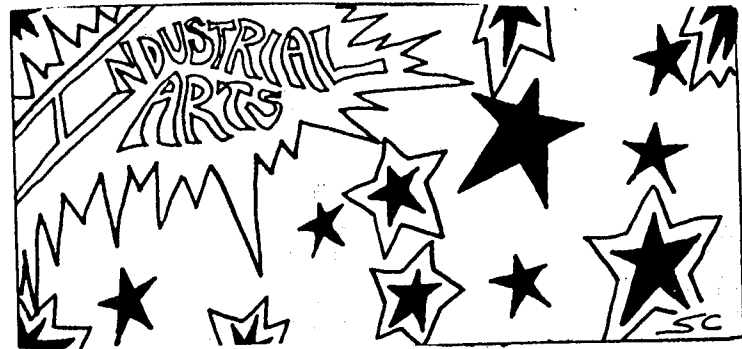


A Practical Use of Space

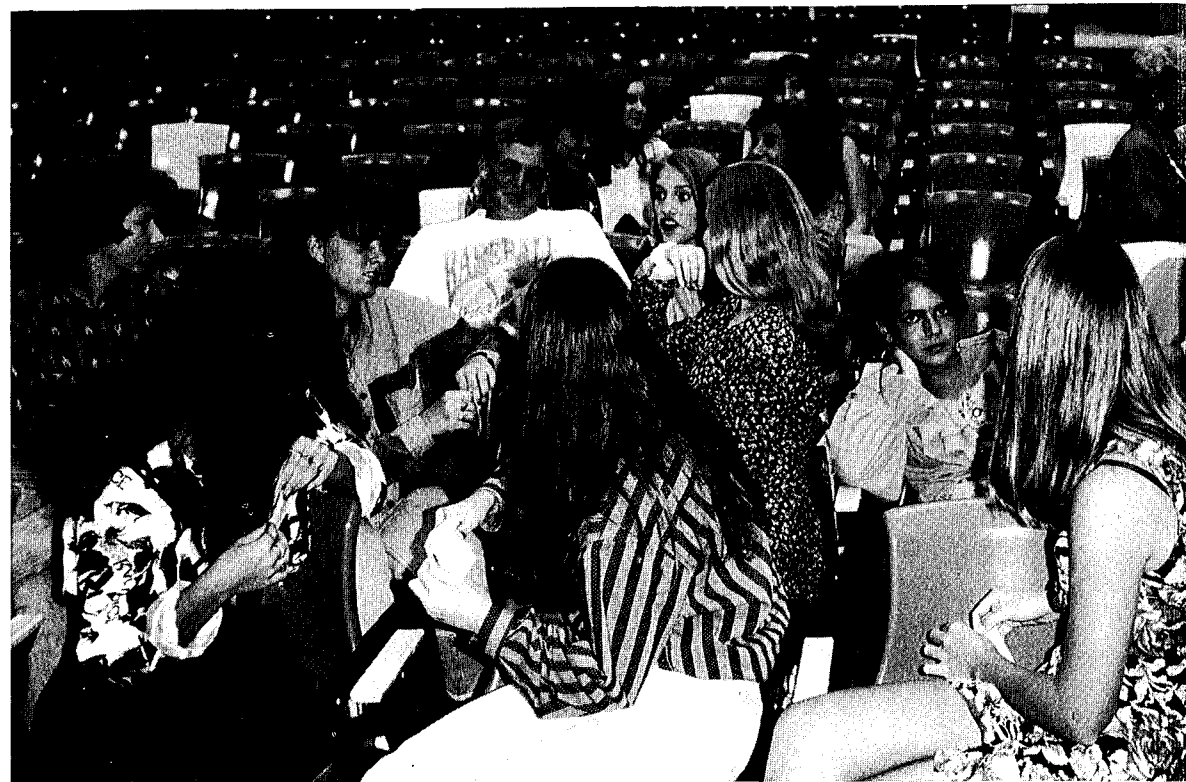
