MCPSS STUDENT EXPECTATIONS FOR REMOTE LEARNING

What Are the Expectations for My Child?

Mobile County Public Schools expects that all students log on to Schoology daily and be prepared for instruction.

Students should:

- **Log in** to Schoology every school day so your attendance is counted.
- **Complete** all of assignments through Schoology on time and to the best of your ability.
- **Participate** in Digital Citizenship lessons as assigned by your teachers.
- **Take responsibility** for your devices, which are being assigned for school use.
- **Follow** teachers' instructions and assigned schedule.
- **Focus** during instructional time, making the most of all learning opportunities.
- **Ask for help** from a teacher if needed. Students can chat, email, or video conference with their teachers.
- **Participate** in intervention via LIVE video conference help sessions as needed.
- **Be engaged** in your learning.

Parents/Guardians should:

- **Check** to make sure that your child is logging into Schoology every day as the MCPSS Attendance Policy will be in effect.
- **Ensure** that your children take responsibility for the device assigned to them for school use.
- **Cooperate with and support** teachers, your school, and school district policies.
- **Communicate** with teachers regularly and as needed.
- **Work with your children** to comply with all district requests regarding instruction and submission of assignments.
- **Understand** that this is a very crucial time in your child's educational journey. Stay positive and remain flexible as situations occur.
- **Remember that we are better and stronger TOGETHER** and our students deserve all of us working together during this time. The quality of their education depends on it.

IMPORTANT STUDENT QUESTIONS ANSWERED:

1. **Do students have to wear uniforms for online learning?**
Students need to be dressed appropriately, but do not have to wear official school uniform.
2. **Do we need to buy any school supplies?** Teachers will notify students of any supplies needed during the first weeks of school.
3. **How will attendance be monitored during online learning?** Teachers will be able to check attendance daily by viewing whether or not the students have logged into their courses through the Schoology platform.
4. **What if I miss the "Live Instruction" in my class?** If you are unable to attend a live session, you will be able to access the recorded lesson at a later time. It is expected students are present for daily instruction.
