Students must be withdrawn from their home school in order to enroll in 2015-16.

## M-to-M Transfer Leaflet <u>K-12</u>

- To qualify, the <u>student's race</u> must be in the <u>majority</u> at the <u>home zoned school</u> and in the <u>minority</u> at the <u>requested school</u>.
- An African American student zoned to a predominantly African American school can be granted a transfer <u>TO</u> a predominately WHITE school only.
- A White student zoned to a predominatly white school can be granted a transfer <u>TO</u> a predominatly African American school only.
- If a child's race is already in the minority at a school, an M-to-M Transfer cannot be granted to any school.
