#### **Parent information form**

Car Riders - temperatures will be taken in the car and parents report if students have any of the symptoms below. The temperature can be rechecked after the parent goes back around in the line for a recheck.

Bus riders - temperatures will be checked and students will be asked if they have any of the symptoms below before entering the building. If a student has a temperature or any of the symptoms below they will have to be sent home. +++ The social worker will assist the health services with parent contacts.

#### Sent home instructions:

(If the students have any of these symptoms please keep them at home, notify the school nurse and follow the instructions below)

### Send home for the following symptoms:

- Fever/Chills/Body Aches
   Loss of Taste or Smell
- Nausea / Vomiting/Diarrhea
   Stomach Pain
- Cough / Sore Throat
   Runny Nose / Sneezing
- 4. Headache

## \*\*\*\* Student may return to school: Date \_\_\_\_\_

- 1. Parents should notify the physician the same day the student is sent home with Covid-19 symptoms.
- 2. After 48 hours (2 days) and the student has **none** of the above symptoms, the student may return to school.
- If a student continues to have the above symptoms after 48 hours, see a
  physician. The school must receive a copy of the doctor's visit and/or
  results when returning to school.
