1. Welcome

a. Dr. Hammond welcomed everyone.

3. Old Business

a. MAP Assessment (STudents were getting prepared to take the MAP assessments.)

4. Adoption of Minutes

a. Ms. Lopez motioned to adopt the minutes from the last meeting and Ms. Dinkins second the motion.

5. New Business

a. MAP Results

- Mrs. Allen shared MAP assessment data and stated,
 "We look at the data to see what adjustments need to be made." She also shared the Student Growth Summary Report for the entire school.
- She shared Fall to Winter results by grade and looked for trends that showed how our students improved.
 We compare our data to data across the state and the growth compares individual students against themselves.

- Mrs. Allen noted that growth above the 50th percentile begins to fill in gaps, which affects school wide achievement.
- iv. Overall, our students grew in every area in every grade level and had achievement growth. Growth increased from 89% last year to 99% growth this year. Westside's growth is consistent at the 99th percentile and some of our accelerated growth is unheard of. Measures have been put in place to continue growth. All of the accelerated growth we are investing in our students (AO, Extra Math, etc.), plays a part in our students growing and our achievement growing.
- v. Dr. Hammond told the council that the next MAP Assessment will be March 20th. Please talk with your students and help them get prepared for the assessment.

b. Campus Beautification

i. Community Partners: A local church (The Assembly of Warner Robins) will come in and beautify our campus. They would like to add an outdoor classroom. They will transition the greenhouse that was donated to us about seven years ago into a science lab. The work will begin around Spring Break.

c. Playground installed

i. The playground has been completed and the students are enjoying it.

d. Calendar of Events

i. The Sweetheart Dance will take place on Thursday, February 9th at 5:00 for grades 3-5. March 9th we will have our next PBIS celebration. March 30th is when we will host our Field Day.

- A parent asked for details regarding 3rd grade's upcoming Market Day. Mrs. Allen responded to her question and gave the following information:
 - A. In 3rd grade they are currently working on the Economics Unit. They are learning about the exchange of goods and services. The students are currently making products for their displays. Parents visit Market Day for the first 15 minutes to shop and buy some of the products the students have made.
