Dear Parishioners,

Thank you for your continued prayers and support. It has been both awful and awesome. My mom's passing was so unexpected. We children were able to be there as she slipped into eternity. We made the emotionally difficult but rational (and in keeping with her wishes) decision to discontinue life support. She died within 10 minutes. I anointed her, we cried, said goodbye, and prayed. We couldn't have done any better.

Funeral planning and preparation were difficult, and I can see my shortcomings in that I don't always appreciate the pain those saying goodbye feel. Please forgive me. It is difficult for me to judge something I am a part of, but

It is difficult for me to judge something I am a part of, but the funeral Mass was beautiful, a true testament to her. I came to see how I took her for granted too much, assuming I would have her for a few more years. So many stories left untold, laughs withheld. She will be missed.

There were two major concerns I had about the funeral, my dad's presence and brother's absence, but things went well. So well, in fact, I found myself wanting to tell mom... and cue the tears. I am so honored that so many would honor my mother by traveling to the visitation or funeral.

Wednesday is Ash Wednesday. See the times for Masses in the bulletin. Note that it is not a Holy Day of Obligation. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are, however, days of abstinence (no meat for those 14 or above) and fasting (1 meal and perhaps 2 smaller meals per day for those 18 to 59 years old). Fridays are days of abstinence as well.

This weekend we will watch the sixth video in the Search series, entitled "Am I Saved":

What Jesus did for us through his life, death and resurrection was the greatest act of love in history. He saved us. He did this for each one of us. Personally. But some might feel unworthy of this gift of love. We may feel we have too much baggage. We may feel unlovable. But God didn't come to reveal himself to us on a pedestal, He came to enter into our messy human condition. To fix us from within. To transform us from the inside out. Some might be surprised by how generous the love of God really is. We don't deserve God's love, but that's the amazing reality of God's mercy. This relationship with God isn't all about our love for Him. It's about His love for us that changes our lives forever.


