- 2. Purpose of this meeting to evaluate the effectiveness of current Title I.A programs and discuss plans for next year.

Mrs. Vestal, Title Reading, gave a summary of the Title I program.

- 3. Title I.A
 - a. Present and discuss student achievement data

I-Ready Diagnostic information for the district was presented by Mrs. Cassidy Herrin for Reading and Math. In Reading the district has 10 Students mid or above grade level, 7 students early on grade level, 18 students one grade level below, 2 students two grade levels below and 2 students three or more grade levels below. In Math the district has 4 students mid or above grade level, 6 students early on grade level, 13 students one grade level below, 0 students two grade levels below and 2 students three or more grade levels below.

b. Review results from parent surveys

Results of the parent surveys for Title and Family Engagement were presented by Mrs. Patricia Hancock. Overall the results were good. Parents would like to know more about Math Skills, Helping their Child to Succeed, Reading Strategies and Homework skills. Discussion was held regarding information that we can send home and Family Events that we could have to provide the information to parents. Parents would like to also see more weekly classroom communication regarding tests and assignment deadlines. Family Engagement was discussed regarding having the events on different nights to help parents with scheduling and including a Family Fun Night Facebook event to help announce the event and remind the parents.

c. Discuss the program's strengths and weaknesses

Those in attendance completed a verbal needs assessment. We found that our K-8 Phonics, general vocabulary supplemental programs and non-fiction reading are working well, as well as, Math Numbers, operations and upper level measurement and data.

Our Weaknesses are in K-8 Comprehension, subject related specific vocabulary (Math, Science, Social Studies), and K/1 measurements/data. Operations and fractions are also in need of improvement.

Some suggestions for next year include: Just Words for the upper grades and Science of Reading for struggling readers, as well as, the continuation of Fundations which everyone agreed is helping. Mrs. Blomquist would also like us to get Division and Multiplication "Wrap Ups" for Math and additional lit. sets for reading.

The current school, parent, student compact was reviewed and there were no suggestions for changes.
