July 2024 Budget Report

General Fund

Revenue receipts for the first month totaled nearly \$142,000. Local Revenue: No significant local revenue was received.

 \mathtt{State} Revenue: \$141,000 was received in SEEK funding. Nearly \$600 was received for revenue in lieu of taxes from the state.

Federal Revenue: No federal revenue was received.

Expenditures through July totaled \$116,000.

School Budget: The school budget is \$27,000. \$3,100 was expended in July. Expenses included \$2,600 on technology supplies/subscriptions and \$500 on copier-printer costs.

Maintenance Budget: Expenses totaled \$17,000 in July. Expenses included \$6,700 on property insurance, \$6,600 on salaries and benefits, \$1,800 on utility services, \$1,100 on equipment rental, and \$500 on professional services. 4.3% of the maintenance budget was utilized in the first month.

Transportation Budget: In July, costs totaled \$10,500. Salaries and benefits accounted for \$5,600. Annual fleet insurance was \$4,600. 6.7% of the transportation budget has been utilized.

For the general fund, year-to-date receipts exceeded expenditures by \$26,000.

Rationale:

The board entered executive session at 6:35 P.M. to review and determine an expulsion extension of KB.

Within thirty (30) days prior to the end of a student's expulsion, the Board shall review the details of the expulsion and current factors and circumstances, including if ending the expulsion will substantially disrupt the education process or constitute a threat to the safety of students or school staff, to determine if the expulsion shall be extended for a period not to exceed twelve (12) months. The expulsion review process shall be used prior to the end of each expulsion period until the Board ends the expulsion or the student is no longer subject to compulsory attendance under KRS 159.010.

EXPULSION HEARING MINUTES

At the September 7, 2023 expulsion hearing of the student, the Board heard testimony from Superintendent Lisa McCane, Physical Education Teacher Joey Crouch, and School Resource Officer Ken Fuller, and received evidence including a video of an altercation involving the student in the school gymnasium on August 30, 2023. Superintendent Lisa McCane recommended expulsion of the student as a result of violating Board Policy 09.425, Assault and Threats of Violence.

Based on this evidence and testimony presented at the hearing, the Board determined, through clear and convincing evidence, that the student, on August 30, 2023: (1) committed assault or battery or abuse of another student; (2) committed assault or battery or abuse of school personnel; (3) committed willful disobedience or defiance of authority of the teachers or administrators; (4) used profanity or vulgarity; and (5) made threats that pose a danger to the well-being of students, faculty, and staff. Based on this conduct, to have the student in school poses a safety issue for other students, faculty, staff, and other school personnel. Accordingly, the student is expelled and the expulsion shall be at least twelve (12) months. After twelve (12) months has lapsed, this expulsion shall remain in place until the Board votes to re-admit the student to school in the district. The mother, nor representatives of the student attended the hearing.
