Dear Parishioners,

One more week of Advent, but a short week. While many in the culture might be counting down until the day, planning on removing the trees in decorations shortly after Christmas Day, we are only gearing up! This last week is a final push to prepare our hearts for the Christ Child, and may He find a welcome home. Like the people around the Blessed Mother, St. Joseph, St. Elizabeth and St. Zechariah, we rejoice in the announcement of His birth, but also know that we are called to live in joy and continued expectation.

Thank you for the prayers for my sister and mother. Both are recovering well, at least at the time of writing. Certainly, it made for interesting times knowing that both were sick but that I could do so little to help them. My mom recovered at home after getting a good course of antibiotics, and my sister was released after 5 days in the hospital. Sadly, one of the days was her birthday – a terrible way to spend it.

We submitted the request for approval to begin the replacement of the sound system at St. Eloi's a week ago, and I am fairly certain that it will be approved. I am grateful for all who have already contributed to this project. I am also thankful to those who have contributed to the school's match grant efforts. At the time of writing, it appears that we have the necessary money in hand to receive the matching grant from the Richard M. Schultz Foundation. This is amazing and I am so thankful.

Finally, thank you to those that contributed to the Diocesan Ministries Appeal. St. Edward's is about halfway to its goal, and St. Eloi has made the goal. A reminder that 20% of every dollar returns to the parish, and so we benefit in not only helping the Diocese fund social concerns issues, Formation of Seminarians and Deacons, and other areas, we get a return on the contributions. All of these are over and above your regular Sunday offerings, which have also been fairly good. As you are aware, the tax year is coming to an end. Any contributions that you wish to have applied to 2021 need to be given by December 31.

This fourth Advent Sunday we are reminded that Jesus offers us peace in every season, and nothing is impossible with him!


WEEK 4 Lighting the Candle
