What are the benefits of my children attending a Title I School?

**Steinhatchee School  
A Title I School**

**Title I Funds are used by Steinhatchee School to provide:**

- 1 Teacher and 2 Paraprofessionals
- Classroom materials and curriculum
- Family Engagement materials
- Parent/Teacher Communication materials
- Tutoring
- Staff development
- Technology Tools

**Title I Funds are used by the District to provide:**

- Afterschool tutoring (SES)
- Transportation for SES
- Reading Coach
- Math/Science Coach
- Parent Resource Center
- Staff Development

**Title I Funds**

- Allocated on basis of number of students eligible for free/reduced lunch. Schools receive Title I funds if 40% or more of students are eligible for free/reduced lunch.
- Schools are ranked according to this percentage, and schools receive a certain amount of money per student.

**School Improvement Goals**

- Increase the number of students scoring 3 or higher on progress monitoring.
- Increase students scoring on grade level or above on reading, writing, math, and science state assessments.
- 90% or more of students will make a full year learning gain.
- At least 90% of students will be in attendance 90% of the time.
- School-wide average daily attendance at or above 95%.
