Course Description:

This course is designed to produce opportunities for students to develop the necessary skills, knowledge, and attitude to help students with disabilities participate in physical fitness and educational experiences that will make a significant contribution to healthy living and lifestyle choices. The student will be responsible for helping prepare activities, projects and participation daily.

Course Objectives:

The student will participate in fitness activities with students with disabilities.

The student will be able to produce a lesson that is skill appropriate for students with disabilities.

The student will assist in transporting the students with disabilities to and from their classrooms.

The student will pursue physical activities that produce health-related fitness, relieve tension, and control weight in both school and non-school settings.

Analyze how activity participation patterns change throughout life and express strategies

to deal with these changes.

Classroom Rules:

Follow all normal accepted behavior policies set forth by the classroom teacher, VHS, and the Board of Education.

Grading/Course Requirements:

Major Assessments 45%

*Participation Grade

-determined by the daily participation of all activities. This grade will begin at 100 and is reduced by 5 points for each day a student does not participate in the daily responsibilities assigned.

Minor Assessments 20%

*Teaching/Group project

-students will work in groups to plan out daily lessons and teach the class for one week. Students will be submitting lesson plans and leading classroom instruction.

Daily Work 15% *Work Ethic

-determined by attitude and work ethic in daily responsibilities and going above and

beyond to meet the needs of the special education students.

Final Exam 20%

**This course includes a cumulative exam at the end of the semester. The final exam during the first and second semester is worth 20% of the semester grade.

Google Classroom
