WHEREAS, the tentative budget was approved by the Executive County Superintendent of Schools on April 15, 2026 and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was advertised in the legal section of the Press of Atlantic City on April 23, 2026 and posted on the School District's website on April 17, 2026 and

WHEREAS, the final budget was presented to the public during a hearing held in the Media Center at 1201 Atlantic Avenue, North Wildwood, NJ on April 27, 2026

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education approved the 2027-2027 North Wildwood School District Budget as follows:

CAPITAL RESERVE WITHDRAWAL

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that included in the General Fund appropriations, budget line 600 is a withdrawal from Capital Reserve - for Local Share in the amount \$749,000. Projects include: Update Athletic Fields, Cafeteria/Kitchen upgrade, Home Economics Room update, Repaint Building (phase 1) Upgraded Security

MAINTENANCE RESERVE WITHDRAWAL

BE IT RESOLVED that as per N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-14.2(d) the General Fund appropriations include \$150,000 to be withdrawn from the Maintenance Reserve Account to be utilized for required maintenance activities as reported in the comprehensive maintenance plan pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:26-20.5.

TUITION RESERVE WITHDRAWAL

BE IT RESOLVED that the General Fund appropriations include \$126,541 to be withdrawn from the Tuition Reserve Account.

EMERGENCY RESERVE ACCOUNT

BE IT RESOLVED that the General Fund appropriations include \$150,000 to be withdrawn from the Emergency Reserve Account to be utilized for the increase in Health Benefits for the 2026-27 Budget

TRAVEL AND RELATED EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT 2026-2027

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WHEREAS, the North Wildwood Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3 et seq. requires Board members to receive approval of these expenses by a majority of the full voting membership of the Board and staff members to receive prior approval of these expenses by the Superintendent of Schools and a majority of the full voting membership of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the North Wildwood Board of Education established \$20,000 as the maximum travel amount for the current school year and has expended \$0.00 as of this date; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.3, to a maximum expenditure of \$20,000 for the 2026-2027 school year.
