Dear Parishioners,

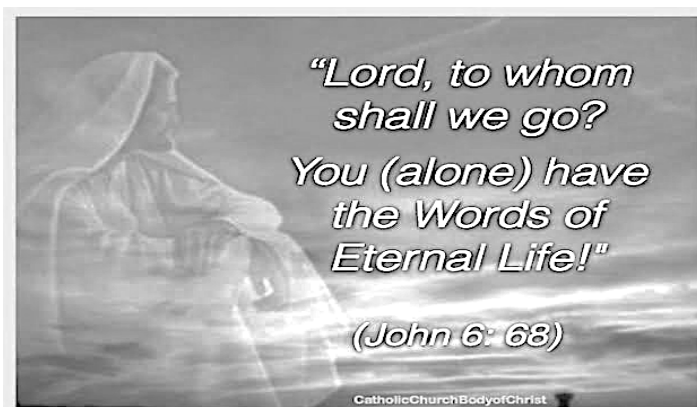

While some may have difficulty using these tables, the presence of tables that our children can use outweighs the difficulty.

With the two funerals this past week, I wish to thank the funeral crew for their service. As I may have said, we might overlook the true importance of the funeral luncheon – it is not just about eating. There is something profoundly Catholic about eating together, as we become companions in the original meaning of the word. Even if we are not literally “joining together with bread”, the luncheon is about coming together to share life, with its joys and sorrows, and to walk together, even if brief, in the shared grief.

Those who prepare, serve, and clean up during the luncheons provide much more than a corporal work of mercy (after all, most of us are not truly starving), as they are comforting the sorrowful and encouraging prayers for the living and dead by the food and conversation that accompanies it. I would hope that our servers know this high task, and never cease to do so aware that they are serving God.

Eucharistic Revival Information

REFLECTION ~ Think about this ...

Let us reflect today on another important aspect of our preparation for Mass: the eucharistic fast. From the earliest times, it was a custom that the Eucharist only be given to those who were fasting. Pope Pius XII wrote,

Abstinence from food and drink is in accord with that supreme reverence we owe to the supreme majesty of Jesus Christ when we are going to receive him hidden under the veils of the Eucharist. And moreover, when we receive his precious Body and Blood before we take any food, we show clearly that this is the first and loftiest nourishment by which our soul is fed and its holiness increased. (Christus Dominus)

Today, the Church asks that, as a minimum, we fast at least one hour before holy communion, which is roughly half an hour before Mass. Water and medicine are an exception, and the elderly, infirm, and those who care for them are exempt (Canon 919). But let us remember, that the Church requires this as the bare minimum.

The fast is an invitation to reflect on what we are about to partake in. It is meant to lead us to Christ, to prepare our body and soul to receive him. If half an hour before Mass is not doing that for us, perhaps we need a stronger reminder that our Eucharistic Lord is "the food which endures to eternal life" and that Holy Communion is the peak of our day, our week, and our life.

Let us pray.

Lord, you have given us your Body and Blood as true heavenly food. Grant that by worthily partaking of this Sacrament we may come to love and seek you above all things and free ourselves from the chains that bind us to this passing world. We ask this in your most holy name. Amen.

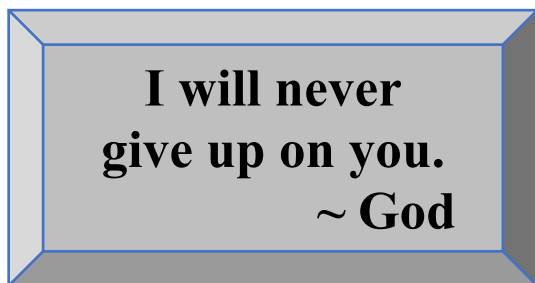
