Attendance Policy

- Attendance is taken separately for each class.
- Students with more than 5 absences in any class MAY be denied credit. The student must complete attendance waivers for these classes.
- In order to grant credit for a class with more than 5 absences, an attendance waiver must be completed at the end of the semester.
- The Attendance Committee then determines whether the credit should be granted or denied.



Attendance Policy

- When students return from being absent, an excuse note must be submitted to Mrs. Crotts in the Guidance Office.
- Students should submit the note before 8 A.M.
- If a note has not been submitted within 2 days of the absence, it may be marked as an unexcused absence.

Attendance Policy



- Turn in Attendance notes and check out students using the window to the left of the Administration building doors (pictured below)





Tardy Policy

- If a student is tardy, the student will not be allowed into class.
- The student must report to Mrs. Davis in the Attendance Office for a tardy slip. (Picture on next slide)
- The student will provide the tardy slip to the teacher to get into class.
- Tardies are cumulative. This means that a tardy to 1st period and to 3rd period equals two tardies.
- Tardies are recorded in PowerSchool.
- After 4 tardies, there will be disciplinary consequences.

Tardy Policy



Tardy Number	Consequence
1-3	Warning
4	1 lunch or afterschool detention
5	2 lunch or afterschool detentions
6	3 lunch or afterschool detentions
7	4 lunch or afterschool detentions
8&9	5 lunch or afterschool detentions
10	1 day of ISS and a parent conference with administrator
11	3 days of ISS and the revocation of driving privileges for 1 week
12	5 days of ISS and the revocation of driving privileges for 1 week
13+	1 day of Intervention Center and the revocation of driving privileges for 1 week, or an equivalent consequence as deemed by an administrator



Check-Out Policy

- To check-out during the school day, the student must bring a handwritten note signed by a parent/guardian to Mrs. Crotts in the guidance office before 8 A.M.
- If a note from home is not turned in, a parent/guardian must come to school in person to check-out students.
- Check-outs via phone or email will NOT be allowed.

Student Dress Code – RCSS Board Policy

- Examples of prohibited dress or appearance include, but are not limited to those below:
 1. Head apparel (hats, headbands, scarves, bandanas, picks, combs, etc.) or sunglasses may not be worn inside the building unless the headgear is worn based on a sincerely-held religious belief
 2. Exposed undergarments
 3. Halter tops, tank tops, spaghetti straps (no bare shoulders)
 4. Pants that are baggy or drag the floor (pants/shorts must be worn around the waist)
 5. Short shorts or excessively short dresses/skirts
 6. Spandex or other very tight clothing, or excessively oversized clothing
 7. Sleepwear or bedroom slippers
 8. Bare feet
 9. Clothing that contains advertisements for tobacco, alcohol, or drugs; pictures of graphics of nudity; words that are profane, lewd, vulgar, or indecent or likely to be disruptive to the learning environment
 10. Items that are potentially dangerous such as fish hooks, chains, or spiked objects
 11. Any symbols, styles or attire worn with the intent to convey membership or affiliation in a gang

HATS: Students are not permitted to wear hats inside buildings. This includes all classrooms, labs, interior hallways, the media center, cafeteria and gym.



Transportation

- **Bus Riders:** Please visit the Bus Transportation table in the courtyard following this session or contact Mr. Jim Rogers.
- **Car Riders:** Drop-off and pick-up is in the front circle only
- **Student Drivers:** Please visit the Student Parking table in the courtyard or contact Mrs. Tammie Swaim. Parking enforcement will begin on August 30th.



Before School

- Car Riders begin drop-off in the front circle at 7:30am.
- Breakfast is available in the cafeteria from 7:30-7:55am.
- The Media Center is open for students beginning at 7:45am.
- Class buildings are locked to students until 7:55am daily. Students may stand out in the courtyard or sit inside the cafeteria or media center prior to the first bell.



Lunch

- All students will eat lunch in the cafeteria this year.
- Social distancing will be recommended.
- Outside fast food deliveries will not be permitted or accepted.
- Students must either pack a lunch and bring it to school with them or purchase lunch in the cafeteria.
- Microwaves are available in the cafeteria.
