### **Requirements:**

Seniors who have fulfilled the following requirements are eligible for graduation cords their senior year.

A. Students must be active participants in the Senior Beta club for 3 years.

To be an active participant members must ...

- 1) attend a minimum of 70% of club meetings
- 2) participate in a minimum of 70% of club activities
- 3) log a minimum of 15 hours community service each year
- 4) pay all local and national dues

B. Dues must be paid by the deadline set by the sponsor.

C. Students must remain in good standing with the school and club throughout their time in high school.

To be in good standing means....

- 1) No discipline issues with the school
- 2) Must maintain a 90+ cumulative GPA, with no failing grades.

Students whose GPA drops below 90 will be placed on probation and can remain in the club provided their grades return to a 90 average the next semester.

All students are required to maintain a high academic average and participate in activities. Students who do not maintain a high academic average, participate in activities and remain in good standing with the school will be given a one semester probation period before being dismissed from the club.

**Recognition:** Beta recognition program will be in April. Seniors who have fulfilled their club requirements for their sophomore, junior, and senior years will receive a Beta cord to wear at graduation. Underclassmen will receive their induction pins at this time also.
