## DRAFT – Unofficial Until Approved Meeting Minutes 1/11/2018

The Governing Board of the Tanque Verde Unified School District #13, Pima County, Tucson, Arizona held a Regular Board meeting on January 11, 2018 in the Board Room, at the Tanque Verde Unified School District Administrative Office, 2300 N. Tanque Verde Loop Rd., Tucson, Arizona 85749. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

#### 2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

**MOTION:** Mr. Ruiz made a motion to approve the agenda, with exception; he requested Action Items A and D be moved and heard before the Consent agenda. Ms. Fry seconded; the motion carried unanimously.

#### 3. REPORTS

• Student Board Member Report – Kaitlyn McWilliams

#### Tanque Verde High School

- Superintendent's Report Dr. Scott Hagerman

#### > State of the State

Dr. Hagerman announced he attended the State of the State earlier this week as a guest of Senator Bradley. Senator Bradley serves on a subcommittee relating to the School Facilities Board (SFB). He is asking for updates relating to the progress of our SFB projects and has offered to help keep the process moving forward.

### ➤ 2018-19 Calendar Update

Dr. Hagerman described to Board Members the process he implemented this year welcoming everyone, who chooses to, to weigh-in on the 2018-19 Calendar. The proposed calendar includes input we've received from the survey, (parents, students and staff) site councils, and the calendar committee (parents, staff and administration) is now under review by the transportation department and we are confirming there aren't any concerns with the instructional minutes. Once this process is complete, the calendar will be presented to the Governing Board for consideration and approval.

#### Certified FTE 2018-19 SY

Dr. Hagerman announced certified 2018-19 certified contracts will be sent out sometime next week. Recruitment season is officially underway; we will be involved in local job fairs and are registered to participate in the U of A job fair. We hope to have all positions filled by March.

### • Legislative Report – Mr. Jeff Neff

Mr. Neff said that he, unfortunately, was unable to attend the State of the State due to illness and was happy to hear Dr. Hagerman was in attendance.

Mr. Neff reported that Governor Ducey is experiencing political pressure to try and fix education funding. The economy is picking up which may help, but they are still trying to figure out *how* to fix the funding.

A Legislative District Town Hall with Senator Bradley, Representative Engel and Representative Clodfelter is scheduled on Saturday, January 20, 2018 from 10 a.m. to 12 noon at the Miller-Golf Links Library 9640 E Golf Links Rd.

Mr. Neff also discussed Proposition 301 which is set to expire in mid-2021. State Rep. Doug Coleman is proposing (HB 2158) to permanently continue the education sales tax. The sales tax will be gone unless voters approve an extension of the tax in the 2018 or 2020 election or if two-thirds of the state's 90-member Legislature passes legislation to maintain the funding.

Mr. Ruiz attended a JTED meeting last week, with other business owners to try to promote JTED education in Arizona schools and funding. Mr. Schalk said he is involved Southern Arizona Manufacturing Partners (SAMP) which is a group of Manufacturing Business owners who are involved in and wanting to help develop a workforce through JTED. The four main trade groups represented are Automotive, Agriculture, Precision Manufacturing and Construction – adding, Legislators need to hear from business owners as well as educators.

There was a request from Ms. Carrie Radomsky requesting permission to address the Governing Board on the following items that DO NOT appear on the agenda:

Graduation requirements survey:

- Students did not receive in school email

- Graduation credits were 24 now the policy reflects 23 credits (foreign language removed completely) wasn't just Spanish II dropped last year?

Mr. Neff requested the Superintendent provide an update on high school graduation requirements.

Mr. Ruiz made a motion to nominate Mr. Jeremy Schalk to serve as the Governing Board Clerk. Mr. Neff seconded; the motion carried unanimously.

- D. Board consideration for New Positions Dr. Scott Hagerman
  - i. Assistant to the Principal at ACES
  - ii. Transportation Technician

The Assistant to the Principal (a certified position) at ACES is necessary to help provide general administrative support and service to the Principal. Agua Caliente Elementary School is the only site that does not have any other administrative support on campus.

The transportation technician position will support current staff and allow for the best practices in dispatching, routing, and auditing systems.

**MOTION:** Mr. Ruiz made a motion to approve the new positions: Assistant to the Principal at ACES and the Transportation Technician. Mr. Neff seconded; the motion carried unanimously.

#### 8. ACTION ITEMS

B. Emergency Operation Plan – Ms. Claire Place

Board members were very complimentary, and appreciated the attention to detail in the Emergency Operation Plan (EOP). Ms. Place explained there were several people involved in the process, Ms. Fry thanked Ms. Place for pulling it all together. A follow up question relating to thresholds and what our protocols are relating to outbreaks, "we're in the middle of flu season." Ms. Place and Dr. Hagerman both addressed the question, stating we follow the guidelines from the Health department relating to infectious disease protocols.

<u>MOTION:</u> Mr. Ruiz made a motion to approve the Emergency Operation Plan as presented. Mr. Schalk seconded; the motion carried unanimously.

C. 2018-19 Governing Board Meeting Schedule – Dr. Scott Hagerman

Ms. Fry noted the Thursday, May 24, 2018 board meeting date should be changed to Tuesday, May 22, 2018 to coincide with high school graduation.

<u>MOTION:</u> Mr. Neff made a motion to approve the 2018-19 Calendar. Mr. Auslander seconded. Mr. Neff amended his motion to include the changes noted by Ms. Fry; the May 24, 2018 board meeting is changed to May 22, 2018. Mr. Auslander seconded again; the motion carried unanimously.

E. Scope and Sequence for Gifted Education – Dr. Scott Hagerman

Dr. Hagerman stated the Tanque Verde School District is committed to providing a quality education for gifted students. The Scope and Sequence Criteria for Gifted Education being proposed will help to provide direction with specific and consistent guidelines. We will continue to look at and refine our program moving forward.

**MOTION:** Mr. Schalk made a motion to approve the Scope and Sequence for Gifted Education program. Mr. Neff seconded; the motion carried unanimously.

F. Statement of Assurance – Dr. Scott Hagerman

Dr. Hagerman explained to Board members this document is required and must be submitted to the State of Arizona Department of Education which states the District has a teacher evaluation system in place.

**MOTION:** Mr. Neff made a motion to approve the Statement of Assurance as presented. Mr. Schalk seconded; the motions carried unanimously.
